## **RULES AND REGULATIONS AGREEMENT**

For CBYDR to be a successful and productive experience for all, the following rules and regulations have been adopted. **Read carefully!** Infractions are subject to guardian and placement supervisor notification and possible early dismissal from CBYDR!

1. If you drive to CBYDR, park in the designated lot. Check your keys with the CBYDR Staff. You may NOT drive your car until you leave at the end of the Retreat. You must remain at the CBYDR location from the time you register UNTIL check out.
2. You must be present at ALL CBYDR activities. Be on time!
3. Name tags are to be worn EACH DAY, ALL DAY.
4. You may not receive deliveries during CBYDR from individuals or businesses.
5. Obey curfew times and wake up calls.
6. Lock room when not occupied.
7. No sexual contact will be tolerated at CBYDR. We have a **ZERO** tolerance for abuse.
8. No profanity, bullying or gang-related activities will be tolerated.
9. No participant will consume or have in her possession ANY drugs, alcoholic beverages, tobacco, or narcotics. No smoking. No vaping.
10. Treat staff, university personnel, and other conference attendees with respect - or risk early dismissal or being excluded from future programs.
11. Staff will not lend money to CBYDR delegates.
12. Do **NOT** bring electronic devices (TVs, gaming consoles, computers, tablets, etc.) to CBYDR. **A cell phone may be used during free time or in the dorm before lights out, but it is not allowed during ANY meeting.**
13. You must follow check-out procedures before leaving campus: clear room of trash / personal items; return room key and access cards; pick up medications.
14. Signature below gives consent for CBYDR Staff or Campus Security to search rooms and persons for drugs, tobacco, alcohol, and other illegal contraband, including allegedly stolen items.
15. If you are involved in any physical confrontation or conflict, you may be held legally liable for your actions, which could include civil and/or judicial responsibility.
16. Observe dress code.
  - Jeans, pants, shorts should be worn on or just below the waist – no skin or undergarments to be seen.
  - Shorts should be long enough to meet fingertips when hands are by your side.
  - Shirts should be long enough to cover the midriff – NO belly button / skin showing whether standing, sitting or arms raised.
  - Shirts and dresses should not be low enough to reveal any cleavage
  - Please wear dress clothes for the Banquet – skirt and blouse, dress, or dress pants (no jeans)
  - No t-shirts with obscene or suggestive messages or images
  - No tank tops or dresses with shoulder straps too narrow to cover bra straps:  
\*Braless is unacceptable.                      \*Strapless is unacceptable.
  - No pajamas outside your dorm room
  - **Any gang-related clothing is prohibited.**

I understand it is my responsibility to conduct myself in a manner which shall reflect the highest credit upon myself, my parents/guardians, my organization, and my community. I have read and will abide by the above Rules and Regulations for CBYDR Participants. Failure to comply may result in my being sent home immediately and forfeiture of any funds expended.

I understand the stated dress code and will submit to correction by Staff if I do not wear appropriate clothing. I also understand that my unwillingness to dress appropriately may mean that I am asked to leave the Retreat before it is over.
