## CAROLINAS BROYHILL YOUTH DEVEOPMENT RETREAT FOR GIRLS RULES AND REGULATIONS AGREEMENT

For CBYDR to be a successful and productive experience for everyone, the following rules and regulations are in place. **Read carefully!** Infractions are subject to guardian and placement supervisor notification and possible early dismissal from CBYDR!

- 1. You may not leave campus before checkout. If you drive to CBYDR, park in the designated lot. Check your keys with the CBYDR Staff.
- 2. You must be present and on time to ALL CBYDR activities.
- 3. Be attentive during meetings and participate with 100% energy.
- 4. Wear your nametag EACH DAY, ALL DAY.
- 5. You may not receive deliveries during CBYDR from individuals or businesses.
- 6. Obey curfew times and wake up calls.
- 7. You may not be in spaces that are not assigned to you. We have a **ZERO** tolerance for sexual contact.
- 8. **Treat staff, university personnel, and other conference attendees with respect.** CBYDR has ZERO tolerance for bullying, harassment, or derogatory labeling whether the offense is done personally or electronically.
- 9. Lock room when not occupied.
- 10. No participant will consume or have in possession any drug, alcoholic beverage, tobacco, or narcotic. No smoking. No vaping.
- 11. No profanity, bullying, or gang-related activities.
- 12. Staff will not lend money to CBYDR delegates.
- 13. Do <u>NOT</u> bring electronic devices (TVs, gaming consoles, computers, tablets, etc.) to CBYDR. A cell phone may be used during free time or in the dorm before lights out, but it is not allowed during ANY meeting.
- 14. Follow check-out procedures before leaving campus: clear room of trash / personal items; return room key and access cards; pick up medications.
- 15. Signature below gives consent for CBYDR Staff or Campus Security to search rooms and persons for drugs, tobacco, alcohol, and other illegal contraband, including allegedly stolen items.
- 16. If you are involved in any physical confrontation or conflict, you may be held legally liable for your actions, which could include civil and/or judicial responsibility.
- 17. Observe dress code.
  - Jeans, pants, shorts: Worn on or just below the waist no skin or undergarments to be seen.
  - Shorts: Long enough to meet fingertips when hands are by your side. No spandex or compression shorts. If you wear leggings, shirt must be long enough to meet your fingertips when hands are by your sides.
  - Shirts: Long enough to <u>cover</u> the midriff <u>NO belly button / skin showing: standing, sitting, or arms raised.</u>
  - Shirts and dresses should not be low enough to reveal any cleavage.
  - Tank top or dress straps must cover bra straps. \*Braless is unacceptable.
  - No clothing with obscene, suggestive, or gang affiliated messages or images.
  - No pajamas outside your dorm room.
  - Please wear dress clothes for the Banquet skirt and blouse, dress, or dress pants (no jeans)

I understand I am responsible to conduct myself in a way that reflects the highest credit on myself, my parents/guardians, my organization, and my community. I have read and will abide by the above Rules and Regulations for CBYDR Participants. Failure to comply may result in my being sent home immediately and forfeiture of any funds expended.

I understand the stated dress code and will submit to correction by Staff if I do not wear appropriate clothing. I also understand that I may be asked to leave the Conference before it is over if I am unwilling to dress appropriately.
